



Clarinet Repair - Indicative Price List

Clarinet – student models (plastic)	\$30 + parts (*)	\$180 + parts	N/A

(*) Minimum charge. 30 minutes labour included. Extra labour charged at \$60/hr in 10 minute increments.

Play Condition: returns the instrument to play condition – these are usually one-off and straightforward repairs, such as the replacement of a single pad, the straightening of a bent key, replacing a tenon cork or a thumb rest, etc. This repair carries a 90 day warranty on new pads.

Standard Service: recommended every 12 to 18 months. Instrument is disassembled and hand cleaned. Keys are hand polished. Necessary pads, corks, springs and felts replaced. Spring tension adjusted. Key regulation and height adjustment. Tenon corks checked and replaced only if necessary. Keywork lubricated. Instrument leak tested and play tested. This service carries a 90 day warranty on new pads.

Overhaul: generally only needed once or twice in the lifetime of an instrument, and possibly never for school or beginner instruments. This really depends on the age of the instrument and how well it has been maintained over time. Same as a full service plus: all pads and corks and felts replaced, tone holes levelled/refaced, all springs replaced, bore/wood oiled for wooden instruments. This service carries a 90 day warranty on new pads.

Please note: excessive tone hole/tenon work will incur a surcharge.
